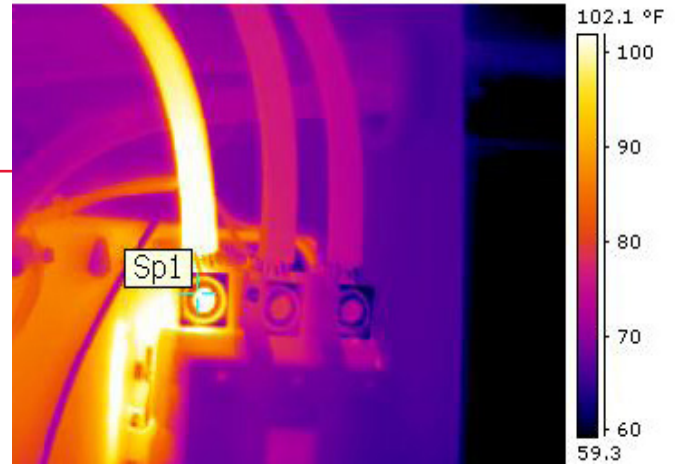




Thermal/Infrared Services

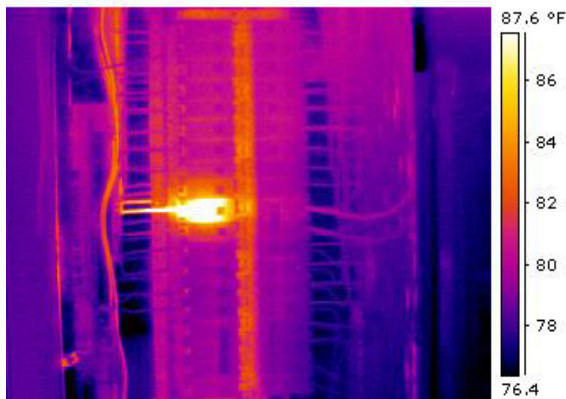

Infrared thermography identifies degrading equipment issues early in their development stages, often before they can be seen or found by other means. A temperature difference, usually an abnormal hot spot, is typically associated with these problems, most often is due to high electrical resistance or excessive frictions.
